Please be aware that there is currently a scam using the Archdiocese name. Recipients receive a fraudulent check bearing the name of the Archdiocese of Baltimore and a financial institution by priority mail. Foxbaltimore.com is reporting the statement by the Archdiocese, Tuesday, March 26, 2019. The link is legitimate.
